Each week, a variety of unique worship services are offered to serve the needs of our community. Try them all & find the one that "speaks" to you!

Worship Service Schedule As is the Episcopal tradition, Communion is a part of all services.

Saturdays

5:00 - 6:00 pm: Reflective, healing service

This is an intimate service with piano and guitar music, healing candles and anointing, and communion passed from person to person around the altar.



Sundays

7:45 - 8:45 am: Traditional, Rite I service

This is our quiet, traditional service with prayer, communion and without music. Coffee hour and fellowship available after the service in the Parish Hall.

9:30 - 10:45 am: Family, Rite II service

This is our largest gathering in a celebration service with children invited to participate in Christian Education (pre K – 5th grade) during the service (Childcare is also available for infants/toddlers in our Nursery). Music Director/Organist Bill French with our Adult Parish Choir perform weekly. Our Children's Choir performs on the 4th Sunday of every month (Sept – May).

10:45 - 11:45 am: Christian Formation

Our Christian education programs (youth in grades 6 – 11) - Rite 13 and Journey to Adulthood, are provided during this time. Under the direction of our Youth Minister, Debra Titkemeier and adult volunteers, this time together sets the stage for many awesome youth activities held throughout the year! Bring a friend, all are welcome.

Adults may also choose to participate in Adult Christian Formation programs that vary throughout the year (check the schedule in the bulletin) during this time.
